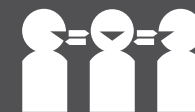

Eligible applicants will attend a workshop to help them prepare to work as an interpreter and apply for a NAATI accreditation test and/or recognition.

This project is fully funded and eligible candidates will be subsidised for the full cost of the workshop and application and assessment fees.
