Pass Requirements	At least Band 2
Band 1	<p>Demonstrates clear and comprehensive knowledge of social institutions, cultural beliefs and practices including the multiple and diverse values across a language group. Includes references to core cultural concepts and cultural dimensions.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Describes accurately and plausibly the cultural and/or sociolinguistic features in a translation and/or interpreting situation.</p>
Band 2	<p>Demonstrates adequate knowledge of social institutions, cultural beliefs and practices including the multiple and diverse values across a language group.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Describes adequately the cultural and/or sociolinguistic features in a translation and/or interpreting situation.</p>
Band 3	<p>Demonstrates limited knowledge of social institutions, cultural beliefs and practices, including the multiple and diverse values across a language group.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Describes some details of the cultural and/or sociolinguistic features in a translation and/or interpreting situation.</p>
Band 4	<p>Demonstrates minimal knowledge of social institutions, cultural beliefs and practices including the multiple and diverse values across a language group.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Does not describe or describes incorrectly the cultural and/or sociolinguistic features in a translation and/or interpreting situation.</p>

Band 2	Adequately identifies the intercultural issue(s) in the scenario as it (they) relate(s) to culturally and sociolinguistically specific concepts in a translation and/or interpreting situation.	Demonstrates an adequate understanding of cultural or sociolinguistic issues and their implications for translators and/or interpreters.
Band 3	Partly identifies the intercultural issue(s) in the scenario as it (they) relate(s) to culturally and sociolinguistically specific concepts in a translation and/or interpreting situation.	Demonstrates some understanding of cultural or sociolinguistic issues and their implications for translators and/or interpreters.
Band 4	Incorrectly identifies the intercultural issue(s) in the scenario as it (they) relate(s) to culturally and sociolinguistically specific concepts in a translation and/or interpreting situation. OR Does not identify any intercultural issue(s) in the scenario.	Demonstrates no or limited understanding of cultural or sociolinguistic issues and their implications for translators and/or interpreters.
