About the position

The Development & Training Officer – Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Languages will report to the Project Manager – Indigenous Interpreting Project and be responsible for creating and delivering training and professional development activities for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander language interpreters and translators who are working toward achieving their NAATI certification.

- Fixed term, part-time position – 12 months and 30 hrs per week
- Location flexible - Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane or Adelaide preferred but other locations considered
- Salary based on the NAATI Enterprise Agreement 2024-2028 (Band 4)
- Salary range for Band 4 - \$97,459 p.a. to \$107,022 p.a. plus superannuation (paid pro rata based on hours worked)

- Demonstrated ability to work effectively with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, communities and organisations, including a strong understanding of cultural protocols, community expectations and appropriate engagement practices across urban, regional and remote contexts.
- An understanding of the language service needs (interpreting and translation) of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.
